Response:

Our college is deeply committed to fostering gender equity throughout our institutional framework, encompassing both academic and non-academic domains. We actively engage our diverse student body in discussions and activities that promote gender sensitivity. As a co-educational institution, Government College Una prioritizes understanding and addressing social issues that specifically affect female students. Additionally, we have established a dedicated NCC unit (1 HP GIRLS BN SOLAN) aimed at cultivating character, camaraderie, discipline, and a secular outlook among girls.

1. Ensuring a Safe and Secure Environment

- The campus is equipped with 24/7 security services, monitored via CCTV with live feeds accessible from the Principal's office.
- Security personnel are stationed at the college gate during operational hours to ensure campus safety.
- Identity cards are issued to all students and are mandatory for access to college premises.
- A first aid facility, managed by a dedicated committee and housed in a designated first aid room, is readily available on campus.
- Separate washroom facilities are provided for male and female teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and students.
- Suggestion boxes are strategically placed across campus to encourage student feedback and engagement.

2. Girl's common Room

- The college provides a dedicated girls' common room equipped with washrooms, dressing mirrors, and a sanitary napkin vending machine. This space is regularly supervised by a designated committee.

3. Age relaxation to girl students in admission

- Female students are granted age relaxation during admissions to undergraduate and postgraduate programs in accordance with government guidelines.

4. Tuition Fee Exemption

- Bonafide Himachali girl students benefit from tuition fee exemptions, reflecting our commitment to supporting female education.

5. Annual Gender Sensitization Initiatives

- A dedicated women's cell, alongside grievance redressal, anti-ragging squads, and a discipline committee, actively promotes gender equality within the college community.
- Regular mentor-mentee meetings and other organized events aim to raise awareness and educate students on issues related to gender equality.

These initiatives underscore our institutional ethos of inclusivity and fairness, ensuring that gender equity remains a cornerstone of our educational environment at Government College Una.

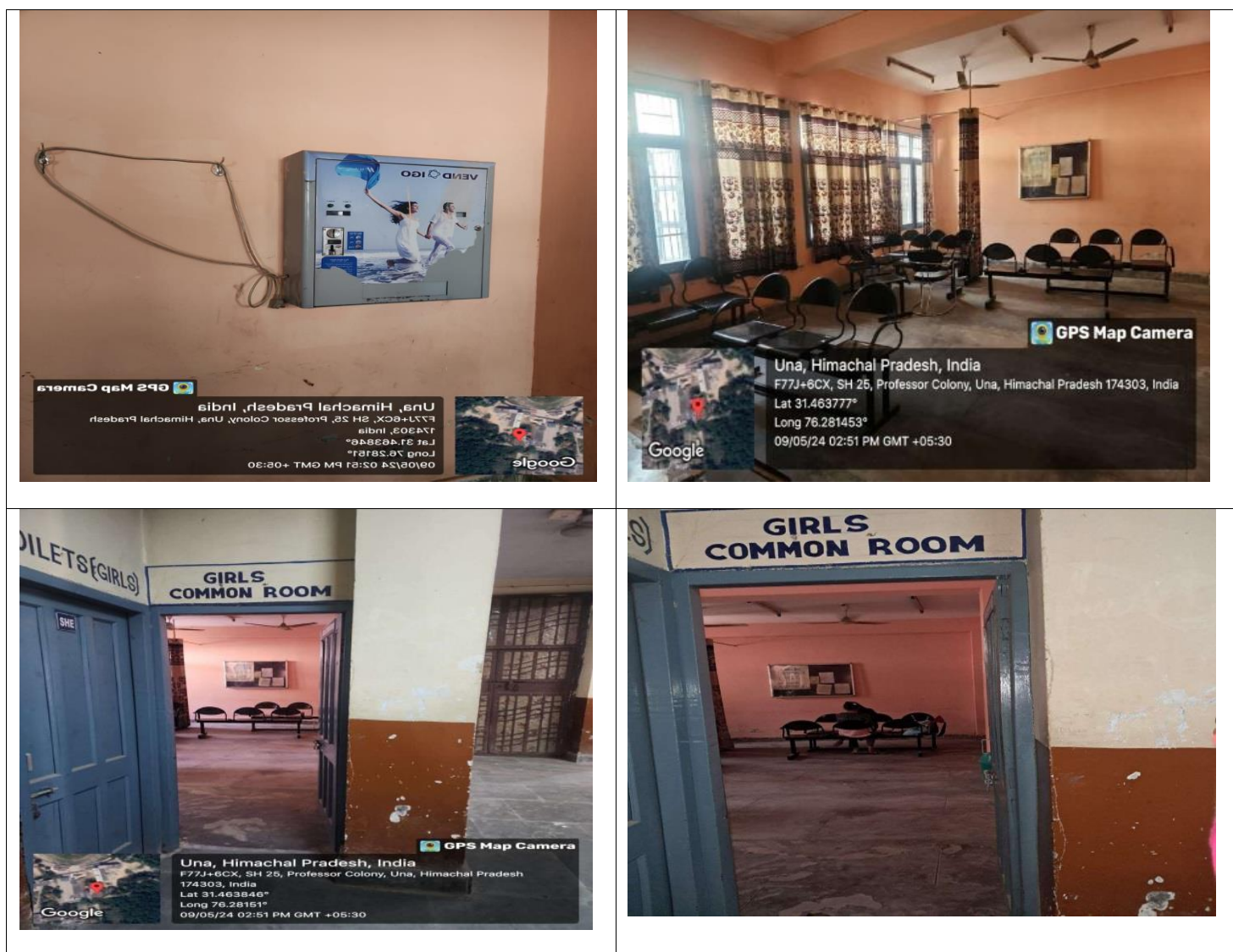


Fig. 1 Girls common room

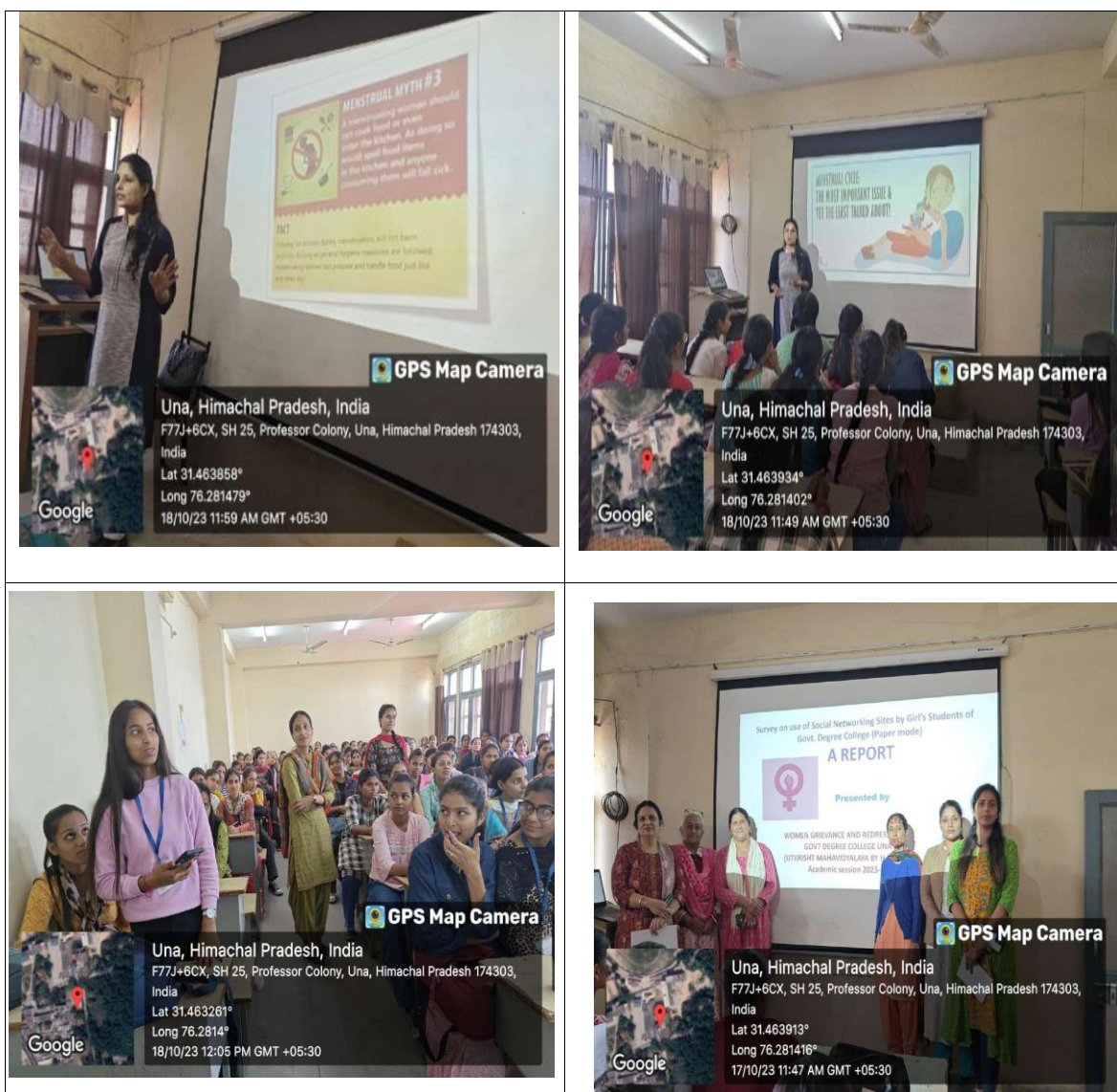


Fig. 2 Activities performed by women grievance redressal cell to sensitize girl students.

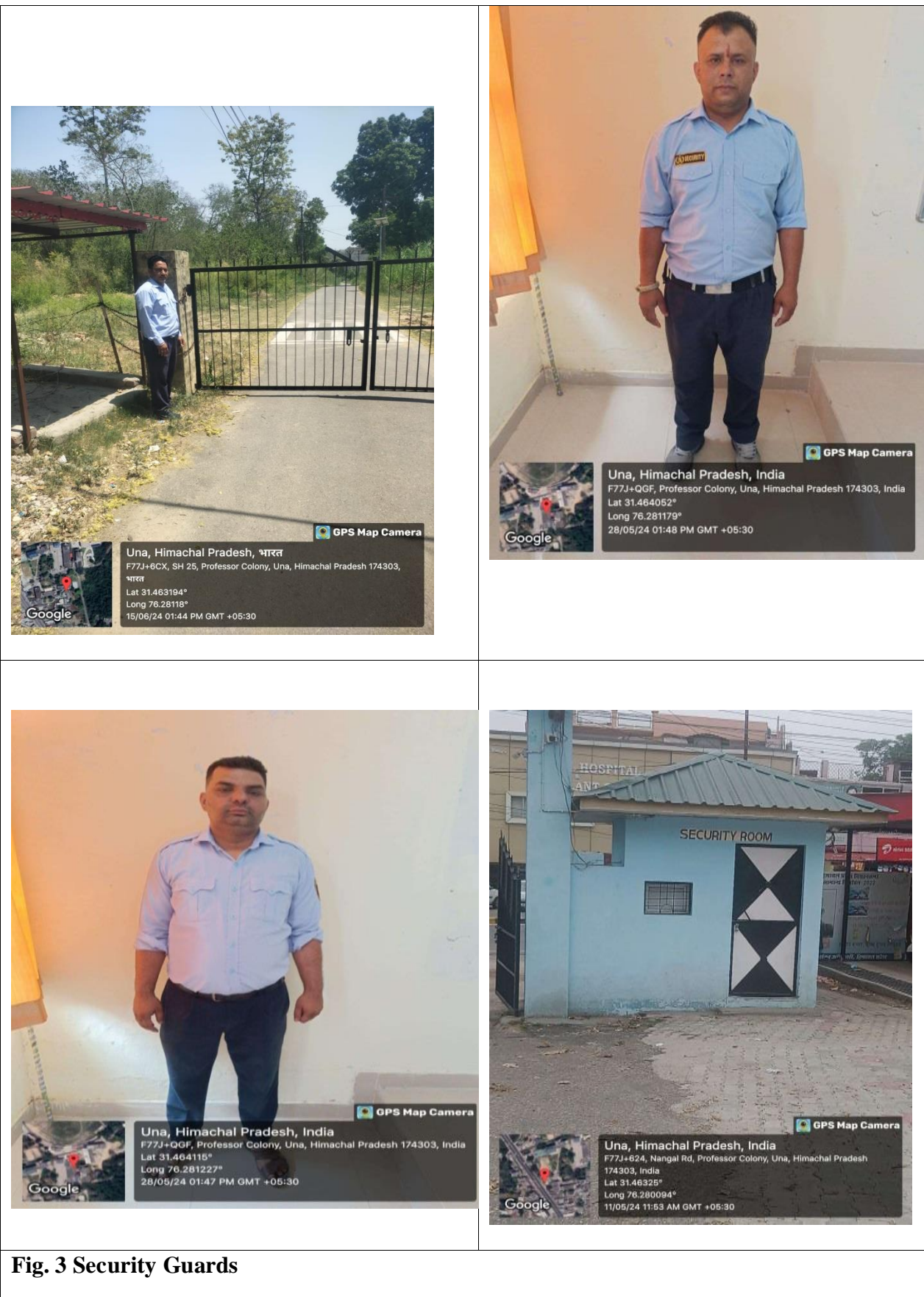


Fig. 3 Security Guards

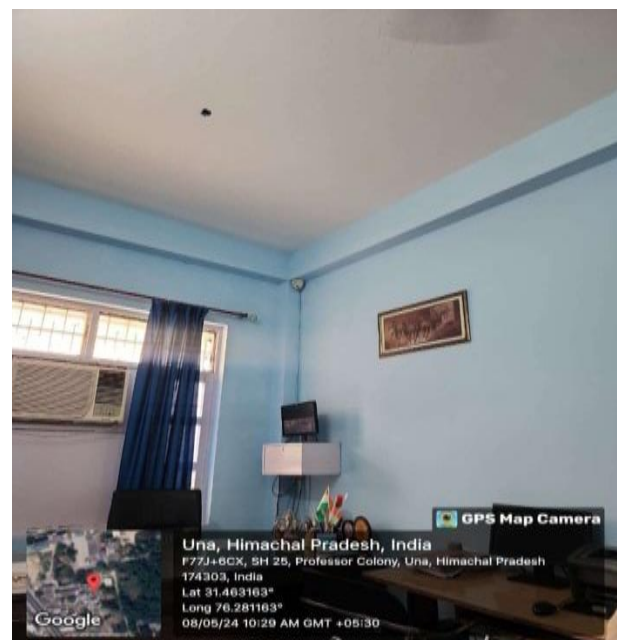
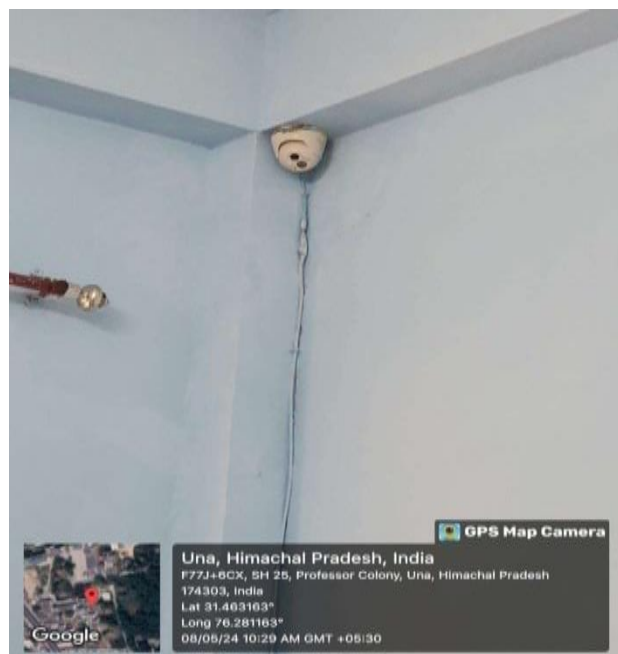
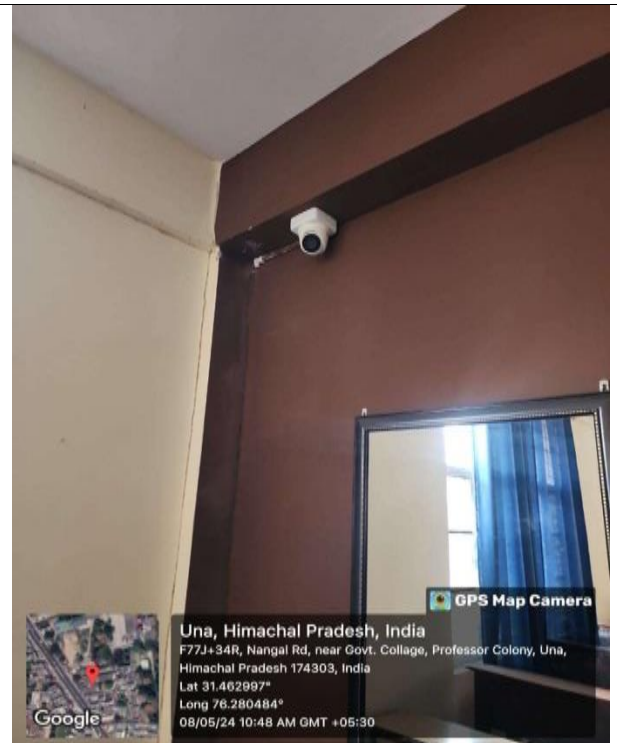


Fig. 4 CCTV cameras installed in the campus.

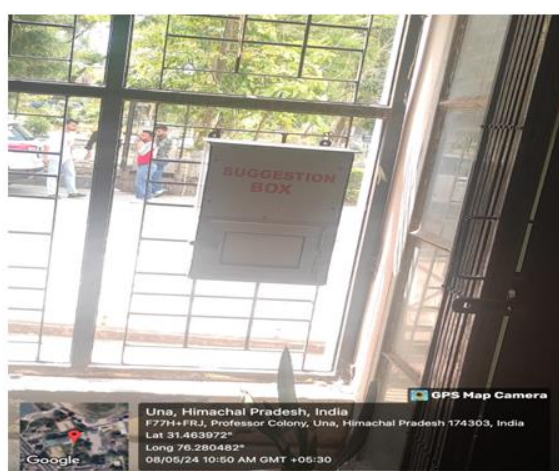


Fig. 9 Suggestion boxes installed in the campus.
