


Figure 1: Gender wise Details of Total Students in the College

The table illustrates the gender classification of male and female student strength by year, as well as the total number of admissions to the college.




Figure: 2 Gender wise Details of Total Students in Arts Subjects




Figure 3: Gender wise Details of total students in Science




Figure: 4 Gender wise Details of total students in Commerce

In commerce the total number of girls are more as compared to boys in all the years.




Figure: 5 Gender wise Details of total students in BBA




Figure: 6 Gender wise Details of total students in BCA




Figure: 7 Gender wise Details of total students in PGDCA




Figure:8 Gender wise Details of total students in B.VOC




Figure: 9 Gender wise Details of total students in MA




Figure: 10 Gender wise Details of total students in M.Com




Figure: 12 Gender wise Details of total students in MCA
