A report on

Pravesh Testing Camp

(February 14, 2025 to February 18, 2025)

A Pravesh Testing Camp was organized for the newly enrolled Rovers and Rangers from February 14 to February 18, 2025 for the session 2024-2025. The day concluded with a joyful and memorable **campfire session**, filled with songs, stories, and laughter, fostering unity and camaraderie among the participants.




