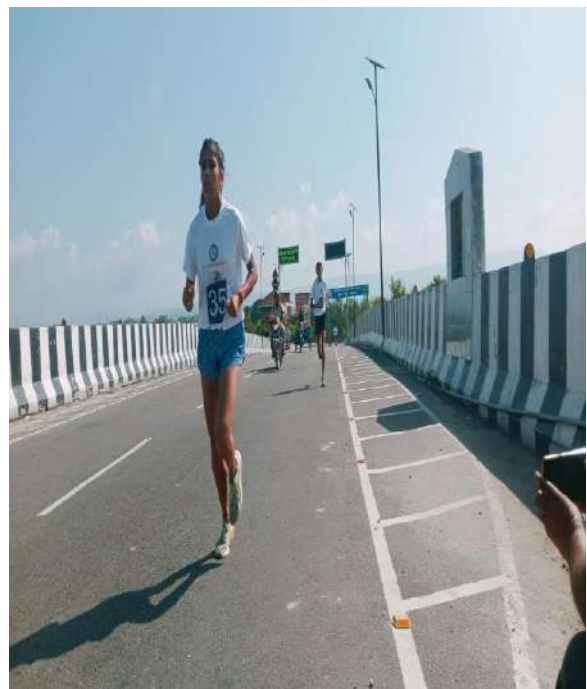

DATED: 15.08.2024

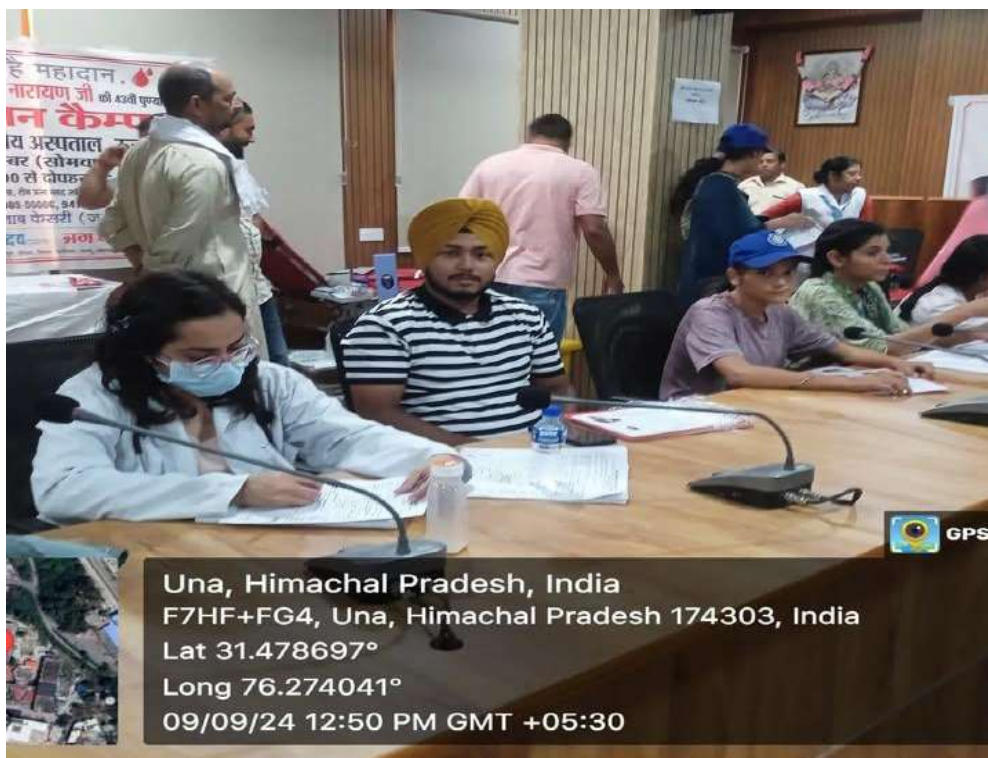

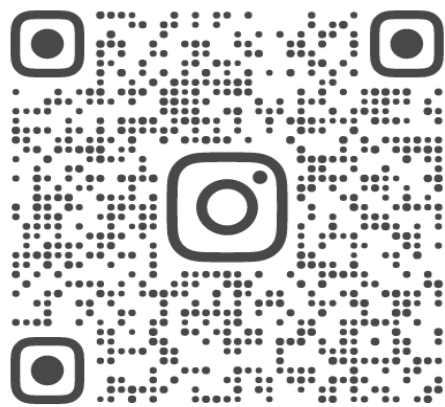


SEVENTH DAY:-

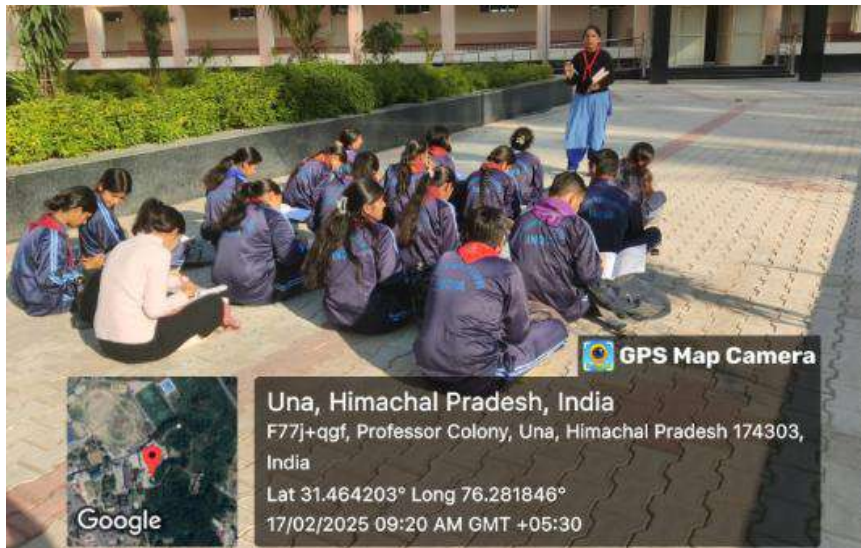

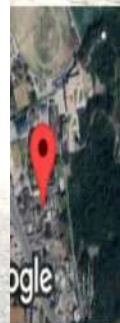
AIDS AWARENESS
