- File Format-MS Word file formats.
- Citation Style: All citations and references must follow the MLA 9 format.
- Presentation Time- 8-10 minutes.

- Each Participant including Author and Co-Author(s) has to register separately for the conference.

छह दिवसीय कार्यशाला: कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता और सॉफ्ट स्किल्स में उत्कृष्टता की ओर एक कदम

The Career Counseling and Training Placement Cell of Govt. College Una (H.P.), in collaboration with IBM Skillsbuild and Anudip Foundation, successfully conducted a six-day workshop on Artificial Intelligence and Soft Skills Development from March 12, 2025, to March 20, 2025. The workshop aimed to equip students with essential AI knowledge, practical applications, and professional skills to enhance their career readiness. The event was attended by students from BBA, BCA, BSc IT, MBA, and MCA, and sessions were held at the MBA/MCA Department from 10:00 AM onwards each day.

राजकीय महाविद्यालय ऊना (हिमाचल प्रदेश) के करियर काउंसलिंग और प्रशिक्षण प्लेसमेंट सेल द्वारा आईवीएम स्किल्सविल्ड और अनुदीप फाउंडेशन के सहयोग से 12 मार्च 2025 से 20 मार्च 2025 तक छह दिवसीय कार्यशाला का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यशाला का उद्देश्य छात्रों को कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता (AI) की बुनियादी समझ, व्यावहारिक अनुप्रयोगों और पेशेवर कौशलों से लैस करना था, जिससे वे भविष्य की नौकरियों के लिए तैयार हो सकें। इस कार्यशाला में वीवीए, वीसीए, वीएससी आईटी, एमवीए और एमसीए के छात्रों ने भाग लिया। सभी सत्र एमवीए/एमसीए विभाग में प्रतिदिन सुबह 10:00 बजे से आयोजित किए गए।

Day 1: Introduction to AI & Certifications

The workshop began with an introduction to Artificial Intelligence (AI), its significance, and its growing impact across industries. Participants were introduced to key AI concepts and career opportunities in this field. Along with theoretical insights, students earned certifications in **IBM Design Thinking**, which fosters innovation and problem-solving, **Resume Building**, which helps in crafting professional resumes, and **Ace Professional Interview**, which prepared students for AI-driven interview processes.

दिन 1: कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता का परिचय और प्रमाणपत्र

कार्यशाला के पहले दिन, कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता (AI) का परिचय, इसका महत्व और विभिन्न उद्योगों पर इसका प्रभाव समझाया गया। छात्रों को एआई मे करियर की संभावनाओं के बारे में जानकारी दी गई। इसके साथ ही, उन्हें आईवीएम डिजाइन थिंकिंग, रिज्यूमे विल्डिंग, और इंटरव्यू कौशल (Ace Professional Interview) में प्रमाणपत्र प्रदान किए गए, जिससे वे प्रभावी ढंग से नौकरी के लिए तैयार हो सकें।



The third day focused on **Natural Language Processing (NLP)**, an essential AI domain that enables machines to interpret, understand, and generate human language. Students were introduced to speech recognition, chatbot development, machine translation, and sentiment analysis. They also received certifications in **Artificial Intelligence Fundamentals**, covering core AI principles, and **Professional Skills**, which focused on communication and critical thinking skills necessary in AI-driven industries.




दिन 3: प्राकृतिक भाषा प्रक्रमण (NLP) और प्रमाणपत्र

तीसरे दिन प्राकृतिक भाषा प्रक्रमण (Natural Language Processing - NLP) पर विशेष सत्र आयोजित किया गया। इसमें छात्रों को वाक् पहचान (Speech Recognition), चैटबॉट तकनीक (Chatbot Technology), मशीन अनुवाद (Machine Translation), और भावना विश्लेषण (Sentiment Analysis) के बारे में जानकारी दी गई। इस दिन छात्रों को आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस फँडामेंटल्स (Artificial Intelligence Fundamentals) और प्रोफेशनल स्किल्स (Professional Skills) प्रमाणपत्र प्राप्त हुए, जिससे वे तकनीकी ज्ञान के साथ पेशेवर कौशल भी विकसित कर सकें।

Day 4: Deep Learning & Machine Learning (Practical Session - AI Image Creation)

Day four was dedicated to Deep Learning and Machine Learning, where students learned about neural networks, data pattern recognition, and AI-powered decision-making. The session was followed by a hands-on practical exercise, where participants created Fusion AI Images using Leonardo AI. This experience enabled students to understand the creative potential of AI in generating digital content.



दिन 4: डीप लर्निंग और मशीन लर्निंग (प्रायोगिक सत्र - एआई इमेज क्रिएशन)

चौथे दिन डीप लर्निंग और मशीन लर्निंग पर ध्यान केंद्रित किया गया। छात्रों को न्यूरल नेटवर्क, डेटा पैटर्न मान्यता, और एआई-आधारित निर्णय लेने की प्रक्रियाओं की जानकारी दी गई। इसके बाद, लियोनार्डो एआई (Leonardo AI) की मदद से फ्यूजन एआई छवियां बनाने का व्यावहारिक सत्र आयोजित किया गया, जिससे छात्रों को एआई की रचनात्मक क्षमता को समझने का अवसर मिला।
