Woman Grievance and Redressal Cell

14th Dec, 2024

Today, our college has organised 'woman grievance cell'. Mr. Sunil and his assistant provides various kinds of guidance related to monthly problem of girls. Firstly, they commence with daily routine by discussing with students who are gathering in the hall. He said within 7 min every third women in India are trapped for uterus cancer and imposed to death. He discussed a glimpse of 'Padman' movies which have changed the mentality of Indians. In India, according to WHO survey all over 3400 uterus removed. They categorised products as health care and personal care. He recommend a health care product to save the life of girls. There were around 80 participants in this session. He exclusively referred the importance of health care and maintaining hygiene in daily life. Participants enthusiastically attended the session and asked queries and doubts to the Mr. Sunil regarding the various health issues and remedies during the session. This lecture also attended by Prof Anita, she shared additional guidance in very informative manner. The session held between 10:00 am and 12:00 pm.
